WHAT IS AN AMBASSADOR? A Kenworthy Ambassador is a student who enjoys the performing arts (including film and theatre) and has a desire to represent the Kenworthy in a positive manner. Ambassadors will be granted free admission to Kenworthy events for one year. In return, the students will be required to create a minimum of 4 “projects” to promote Kenworthy activities to their peers during the 2016-2017 school year. These projects can include (but are not limited to): creating movie trailers, writing film reviews, making posters or flyers, etc. Ambassadors must attend a minimum of 6 events at the Kenworthy during the school year. Students will also be expected to communicate with Kenworthy staff over email and by attending group meetings (held every 6-8 weeks).
